Storing Insulin On the Pacific Sun:

Upon boarding the ship your cabin steward can arrange for your insulin to be stored in his pantry refrigerator. Your cabin steward will discuss with you the best method by which you can easily access your insulin whenever it is required.

Storing Insulin On the Pacific Jewel/Pacific Dawn:

Onboard Pacific Dawn & Pacific Jewel you can also store your Insulin in the refrigerator cabin. All cabins onboard Pacific Dawn & Pacific Jewel accommodate refrigerators.

We do ask that you kindly travel with your insulin in a sealed container clearly labelled with your name and cabin details. Please do not pack your insulin or other medications in your suitcase, keep it with you in your hand luggage so that you have permanent access to it prior to boarding. The cabin steward will also provide an appropriate sharps disposal container. The cabin steward will also arrange for the safe disposal of the container at the end of your client's cruise. Sharps disposal containers are also available from the ship's medical centre during advertised office hours.

We would like to take this opportunity to reassure you that we often have passengers travelling with us that use this method of storage for their insulin without incident and we are confident that you will also find it suitable, however, if you do require further assistance or clarification prior to departure please do not hesitate to contact us.
